



Navi Mumbai: Vashi girl triumphant in shooting tournament, brings home silver

Trisha Mukherjee, a student of Fr Agnel Multipurpose School, Vashi, made the city proud by winning a silver medal in the 10 metre air rifle (W) youth category of the tenth Sardar Sajjan Singh Sethi Memorial Master Meet in Rifle/Pistol. The tournament was held at Dr Karni Singh Shooting Ranges in New Delhi.

Mukherjee secured the second position with a score of 409.4 in the 10 metre Air Rifle (W) Youth category. The tournament was organised by the National Rifle Association of India between August 30 and September 4 in New Delhi.

In the final round, eight players participated and four of them were from Maharashtra. The other players were from Punjab, Delhi, West Bengal and Tamil Nadu.

Mukherjee had also won a team bronze in the international outing in the fifth Asian Air Gun Championship in the 10 metre air rifle (W) youth category held at Nanjing in China in 2012.

Mukherjee represented Maharashtra and was just four point short of the gold. Mampi Das scored 414.4 and won the gold.
